Minutes of the March Meeting

Date: Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at 7:00pm

Attending: Don Grill, Tim Hulihan, Lisa Interlandi, Maria Cassidy, Chris Cantwell, Mark Howell, Russ Ruskay and Council Rep. Searcy.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Don Grill (Chairman)

Don Grill proceeded with the Roll Call, followed by the approval of the minutes of the previous meeting.

During the Recreation Director's Report time...Mark Howell (Acting Director) introduced Russ Ruskay as the New Director of Parks and Recreation. At this time he told the group about his background and experiences and answered any questions they had.

During the new business portion, the group discussed the direction of the baseball league and thought it should be added to the master plan review. There was a reported concern about getting back to more of instructional programming from the community. How is travel team being received and affecting field space for others. Also, how will we deal with patrons requesting to coach.

Council Rep. Searcy had some inquires about whether or not the Village should enact a code that will limit the size of boats in residential districts. The Board discussed some problem areas and boat spacing. They also discussed those renting their home space to others. The group also discussed the definition of "occupant" as it reads right now in the code and whether that needs to be addressed. This will all be followed up on at the next meeting.

The Board discussed who would be available to volunteer for the putting contest at the upcoming Heritage Festival on April 6th.
